A no cost support service for vulnerable families that are not connected or able to access community parenting services.

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

- The program uses teaching tools that are appropriate for individual clients, based on current best practices and research.
- Services are provided in an environment where the parent/guardian feels most comfortable (home, coffee shop, community space, shelter).
- Visits occur based on the individual needs of the family (weekly, bi-weekly, monthly).
- Goals are determined by parents/guardians.
- Services are generally offered for 3 to 6 months; based on family needs services can be extended.
- The program allows parents to build on their already existing strengths and gain tools to use in everyday parenting.
- In-home support and groups address:

Behaviour Guidance
Health & Safety
Attachment
Temperament
Parental Stress & Self-Care
Child Development
Establishing Rules & Routines

The In-home Team services are reserved for clients who face significant economic and social barriers. This program provides:

- practical parenting support
- short term situational counselling (*as it relates to parenting stressors*)
- assistance with system navigation
- advocacy/working collaboratively with other service providers. This may include accompanying clients to appointments with other service providers.

Parents will increase their knowledge, skills, and confidence in raising children with challenging behaviours, developmental delays, and/or mental health diagnoses. They will learn to balance their own needs so that they can meet the needs of their children.

Eligibility Criteria In-Home Support Service

A client of the program will:

- Live within the Greater Ottawa area
- Have a child (ren) between the ages of 0 - 18 years with social, emotional, and/or behavioural challenges
- Be facing significant economic & social barriers
